Salvation - Justification:

Therefore, since we have been declared righteous by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ

Salvation - Justification:

Thus the law had become our guardian until Christ, so that we could be declared righteous by faith.

Salvation - Redemption:

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace.

Salvation - Redemption:

Salvation - Reconciliation:

In other words, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting people's trespasses against them, and he has given us the message of reconciliation. Therefore we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making His plea through us. We plead with you on Christ's behalf, "Be reconciled to God!"

Salvation - Security:

Spiritual Life - Daily Forgiveness:

Bearing with one another and forgiving one another, if someone happens to have a complaint against anyone else. Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also forgive others.

Spiritual Life - Humility:

Humble yourselves before the Lord and he will exalt you.

- James 4:10 NET

Spiritual Life - Good Works:

...and maintain good conduct among the non-Christians, so that though they now malign you as wrongdoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God when he appears.

- 1 Peter 2:12 NET

Spiritual Life - Dependence on God:

But he said to me, "My grace is enough for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." So then, I will boast most gladly about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may reside in me.

Spiritual Life - Daily Forgiveness:

But if we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous, forgiving us our sins and cleansing us from all unrighteousness.

Spiritual Life - Humility:

Instead of being motivated by selfish ambition or vanity, each of you should, in humility, be moved to treat one another as more important than yourself. Each of you should be concerned not only about your own interests, but about the interests of others as well.

Spiritual Life - Good Works:

So we must not grow weary in doing good, for in due time we will reap, if we do not give up. So then, whenever we have an opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who belong to the family of faith.

Spiritual Life - Dependence on God:

Indeed we felt as if the sentence of death had been passed against us, so that we would not trust in ourselves but in God who raises the dead.

Spiritual Life - Dependence on God:

...by casting all your cares on him because he cares for you.

Ministry - Obedience:

The person who has my commandments and obeys them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and will reveal myself to him."

Ministry - Preaching the Gospel:

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the farthest parts of the earth."

If it is service, he must serve; if it is teaching, he must teach; if it is exhortation, he must exhort; if it is contributing, he must do so with sincerity; if it is leadership, he must do so with diligence; if it is showing mercy, he must do so with cheerfulness.

The Universal Church:

He is the head of the body, the church, as well as the beginning, the firstborn from among the dead, so that he himself may become first in all things.

Ministry - Obedience:

So then, my dear friends, just as you have always obeyed, not only in my presence but even more in my absence, continue working out your salvation with awe and reverence, for the one bringing forth in you both the desire and the effort — for the sake of his good pleasure — is God.

Ministry - Preaching the Gospel:

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is God's power for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Church Leadership:

Watch out for yourselves and for all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God that he obtained with the blood of his own Son.

Church Leadership:

When they had appointed elders for them in the various churches, with prayer and fasting they entrusted them to the protection of the Lord in whom they had believed.

Church Leadership:

Elders who provide effective leadership must be counted worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard in speaking and teaching.

- 1 Timothy 5:17 NET

Church Leadership:

For the overseer must be blameless as one entrusted with God's work, not arrogant, not prone to anger, not a drunkard, not violent, not greedy for gain. Instead he must be hospitable, devoted to what is good, sensible, upright, devout, and self-controlled. He must hold firmly to the faithful message as it has been taught, so that he will be able to give exhortation in such healthy teaching and correct those who speak against it.

End Times - Fulfillment of the Covenants:

Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and the prophets and the psalms must be fulfilled."

And we proclaim to you the good news about the promise to our ancestors, that this promise God has fulfilled to us, their children, by raising Jesus, as also it is written in the second psalm, 'You are my Son; today I have fathered you.'

Gospel - People Must Believe:

The one who believes in him is not condemned. The one who does not believe has been condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the one and only Son of God.

- John 3:18 NET

Gospel - Assurance of Salvation:

The Spirit himself bears witness to our spirit that we are God's children.

- Romans 8:16 NET

Gospel - People Repent from their Sins:

For sadness as intended by God produces a repentance that leads to salvation, leaving no regret, but worldly sadness brings about death.
