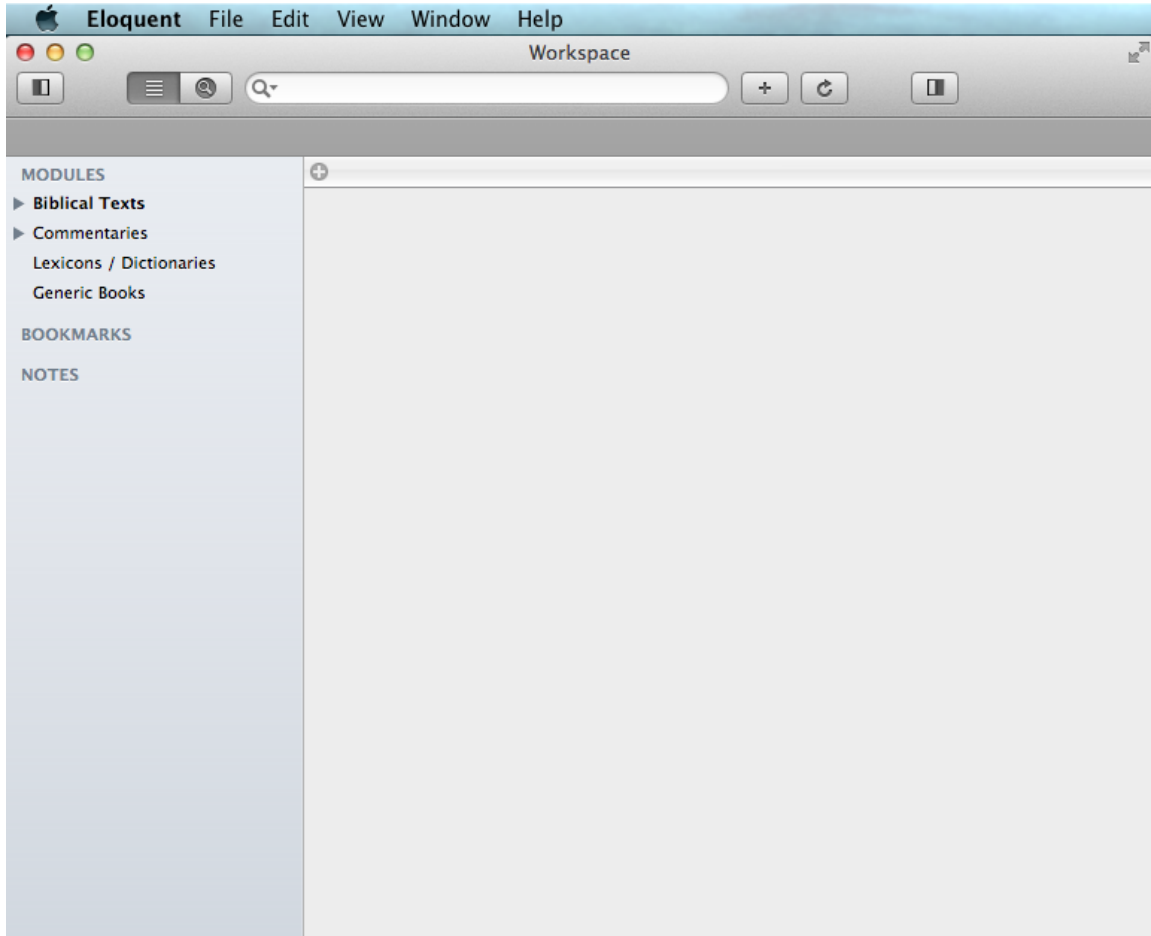
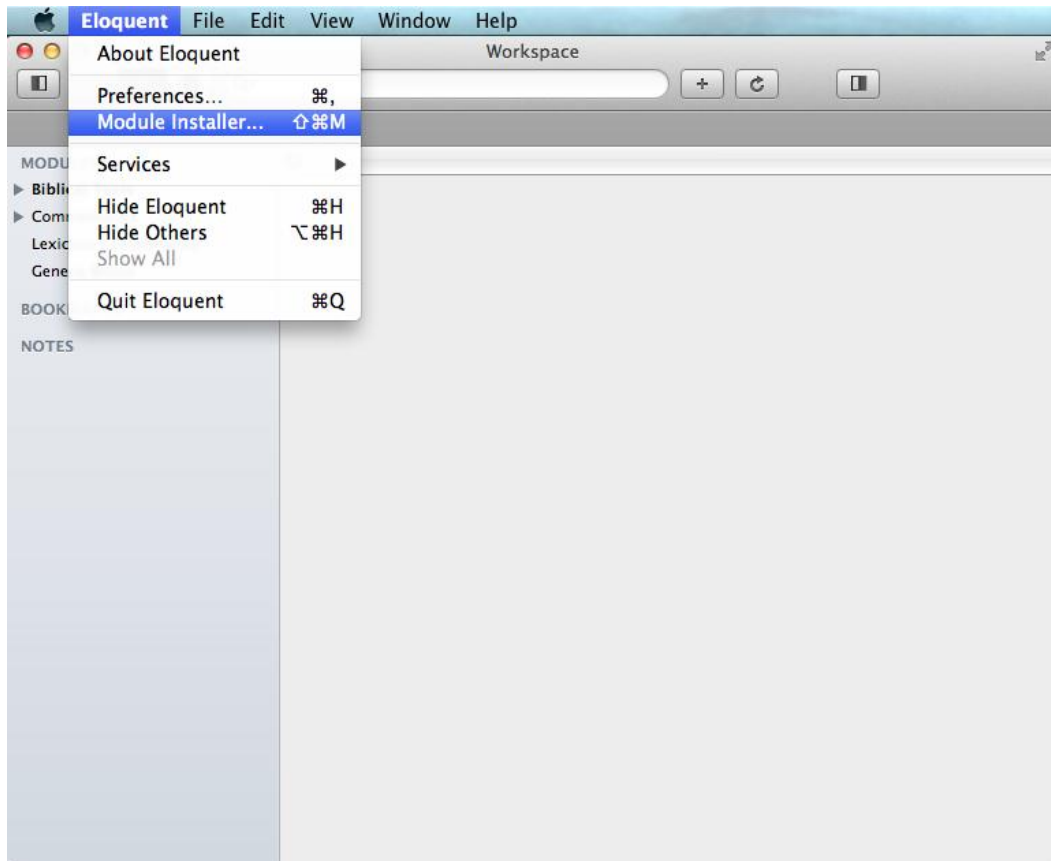


Instructions to install Eloquent modules (for Mac)

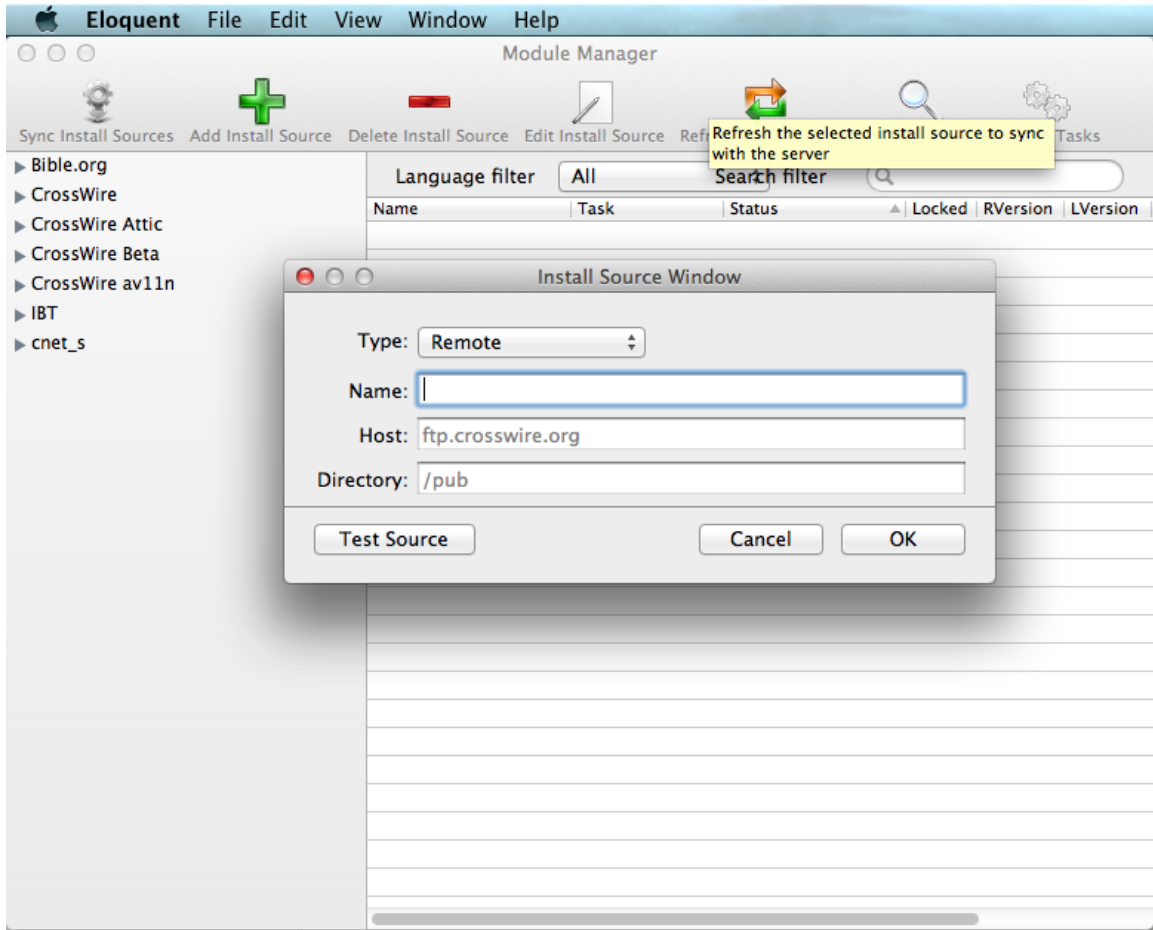
1. Download Eloquent software for Mac from <http://www.macsword.com/download>. Install Eloquent and open it. The interface is like this:



2. Click Eloquent – Module Installer.

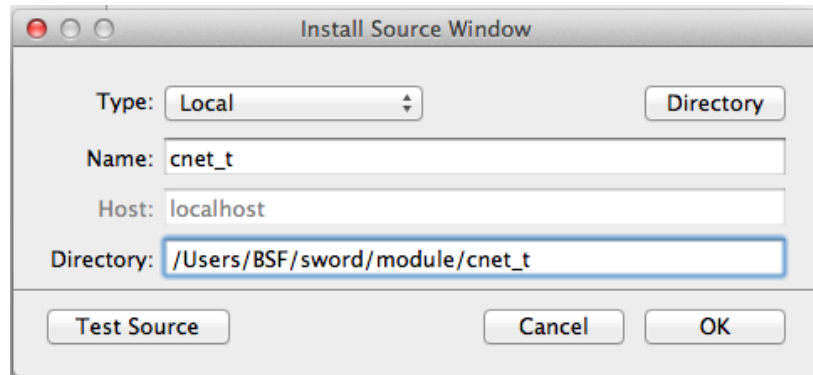


3. The Module Installer opens. In Module Installer, click Add Install Source to open the Install Source Window.

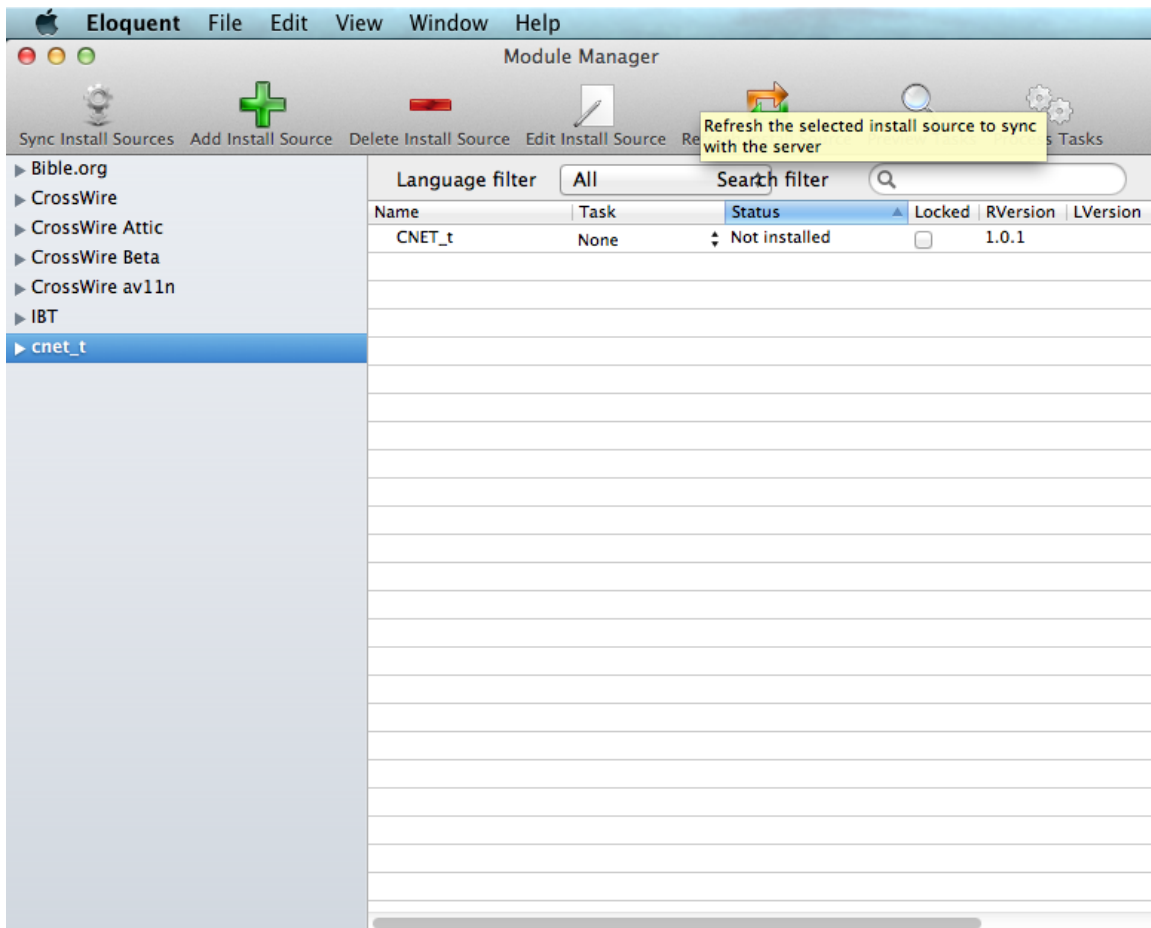


4. Let's install CNET traditional as an example.
 - (1) Choose "local" In the Type dropdown list.
 - (2) Type "cnet_t" in the Name textbox.
 - (3) Click Directory to choose the unzipped CNET simplified module folder.

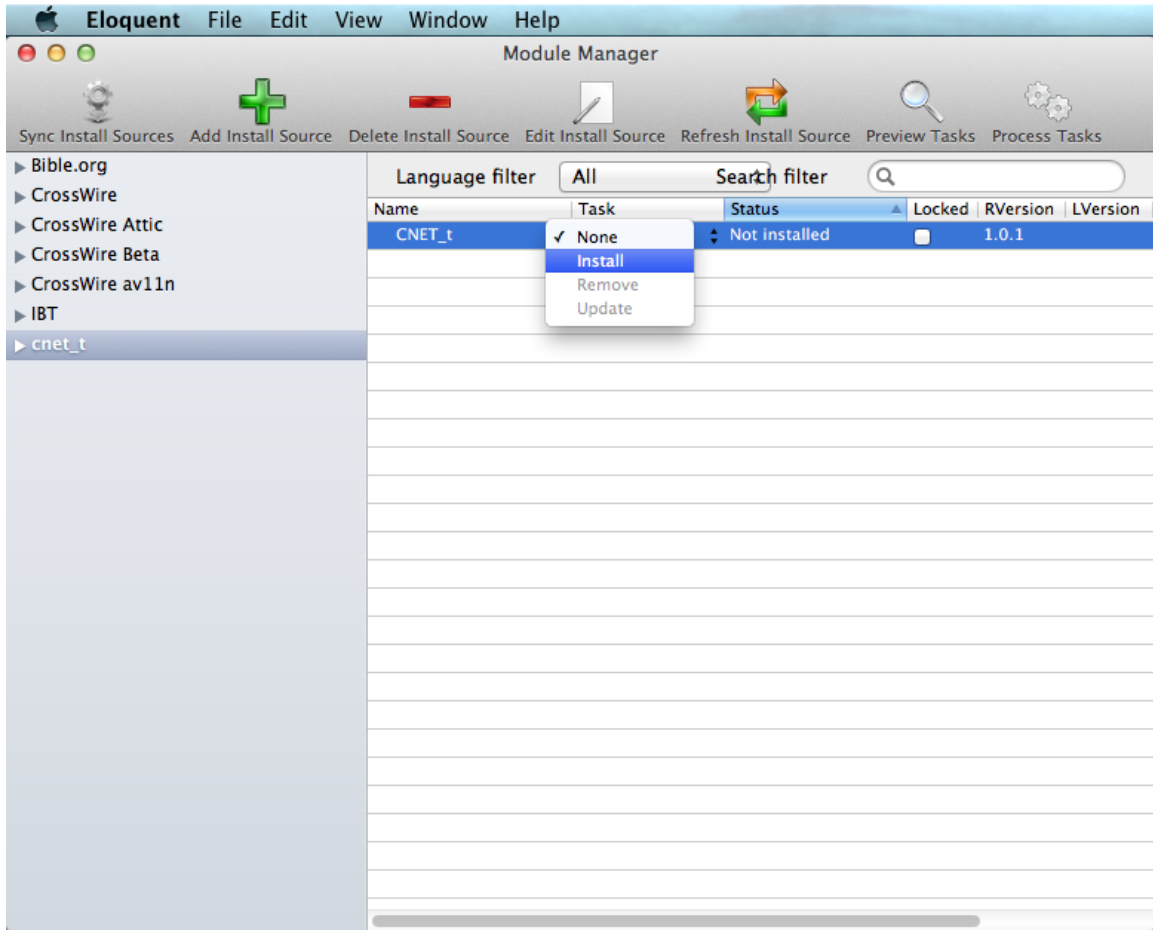
After setting the Install Source, the Install Source Window should be like the following:



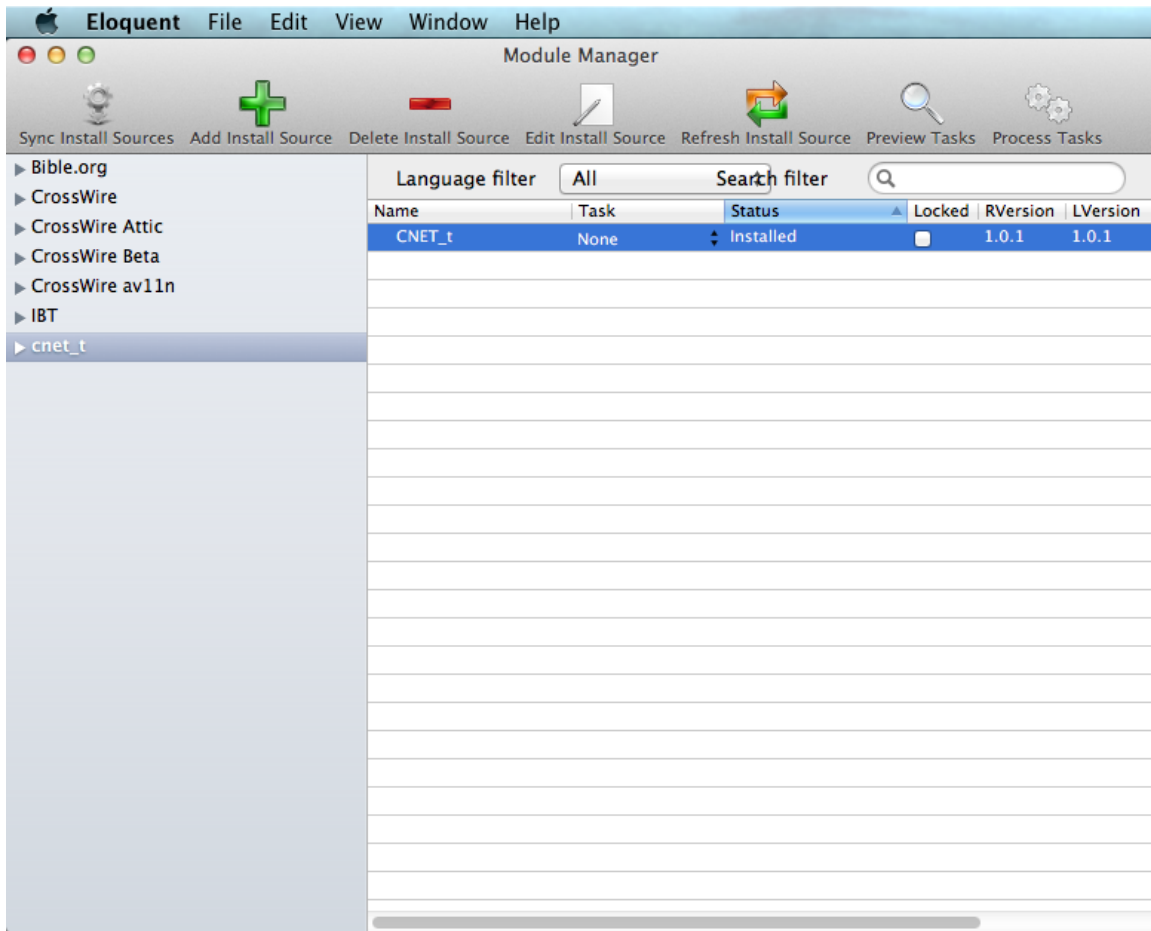
5. Click OK to return to the Eloquent Module Manager. The cnet_t Install Source has been added to the left-hand side of the window. Double click cnet_t, the details will be shown on the right-hand side, as follows:



6. Right click “None” under “Task” column on the right-hand side of the window, and choose “Install”.



7. Click the “Process Tasks” on the tool bar (the top of the Eloquent window) to install the module. After installation, the “Status” column on the right-hand side window should be “Installed”.



8. Close the Module Manager to return to the Eloquent main window. Click the little arrow before “Biblical Texts” on the left-hand side of the window, then click cnet_t. Now you can begin your Bible study with Eloquent!
