    - a. Damascus road conversion - Acts 9:1-19

  - 1. Apostle of Christ Jesus

  - 1. Apostle to the Gentiles - Eph 3:8; Acts 9:15
- D. Paul's \_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. Awaiting trial in Rome - Eph 3:1; 4:1; 6:20
  - 2. Chained, yet \_\_\_\_\_ - Eph 3:1; 4:1; 6:10

### II The Recipients

- A. The saints in Ephesus  
*Saint* = "One who has been \_\_\_\_\_"
- B. The \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ Jesus
  - 1. They \_\_\_\_\_ in Him for salvation - Eph 1:13
  - 2. They were \_\_\_\_\_ in the truth - Rev 2:1-3, 6
    - a. However, they left their first \_\_\_\_\_ - Rev 2:4-5
- C. The friendship between Paul and the Ephesians
  - 1. First, for a short stay - Acts 18:19-21
  - 2. Then for over two years - Acts 19:1-10
  - 3. He met with the elders at Miletus - Acts 20:17-38

- 1. *Grace* = "God's divine \_\_\_\_\_ in spite of \_\_\_\_\_"
- 2. *Peace* = "To be free from \_\_\_\_\_" - Rom 5:8-10

  - 2. The Lord Jesus Christ

- 5. Take a moment to thank God for His indescribable gift in Christ and for the peace that you have as a result of the grace of God in your life.
