## Introduction

### I Paul Expresses His Disciplemaking Heart

## PERSONAL APPLICATION

Take some time this week to consider the following:

- 1. Have you ever been around someone who genuinely made you feel loved and appreciated? What impact does that have on you? How about someone who made you feel unwelcome and insignificant? Which person are you most like when it comes to how you treat others?
- 2. One of Paul's greatest desires was to know God better (Phil 3:8). Take a moment and share one or two of the most significant things you've learned (or are learning) about God recently.
- 3. God wants us to have the eyes of our heart opened to His great blessings for us in Christ. What kinds of things cloud our spiritual vision? Is there anything in your life right now that is preventing you from "seeing clearly"?
- 4. In Ephesians 1:19-20, Paul asserts that the same power that raised Christ from the dead is at work in the believer. Why do you think so many Christians are spiritually weak? How can you grow stronger in the Lord this week?
- 5. Pray for a disciplemaking heart like Paul and for a heart that gladly submits to the reign and rule of your exalted Savior.
