I Be Imitators of God

Imitate = To mimic or copy

- 5. What is hindering you from imitating God more fully -- an underdeveloped 1) relationship, 2) knowledge, 3) submission or 4) obedience? How can you grow in this area this week?
- 6. Thank God for the great privilege He has given you to be His son/daughter, and ask Him for power to be an accurate reflection of His likeness before a lost world.
