## PERSONAL APPLICATION

- 4. Of the 9 characteristics that Paul lays out as marks of godliness (IIB1-9), identify 3 that you would like to grow in.
- 5. What does it mean, practically, to "give thanks in everything?" Does he really mean in "everything?" What is the rationale behind such an exhortation? Do you do this? Why/why not?
- 6. How does Paul's command for us to imitate God in Eph 5:1 summarize all of his following arguments in 2-20?
- 7. Take a moment to thank God for giving you the privilege of imitating Him. Ask Him for grace and power to live as a child of light this week.
