 - 2. He kept in step with God Gal 5:25; Rom 8:5
 - b. He was not because God took him
 - 1. He walked with God Gen 5:21
 - 2. He pleased God Heb 11:5
 - 3. He spoke for God Jude 1:14
 - 3. Methuselah, Lamech, Noah Gen 9:19, 29
- C. They all died Ps 89:48; Heb 9:27
