I Paul Prays For The Believers

- A. He gives thanks to God for them 1 Thess 5:18
 - 1. For their world-renown faith 1 Thess 1:8
- B. He constantly remembers them in prayer 2 Tim 1:3
 - 1. Calling God as His witness whom he:
 - a. Serves with his whole heart 2 Cor 4:5
 - b. Serves by preaching the gospel 2 Tim 4:2
- C. He prays for an opportunity to come to them
 - 1. He longs to see them Phil 1:8

II Paul Explains His Intentions To The Believers

- A. He wants to impart some spiritual gift to them
 - 1. To strengthen them 1 Thess 3:2-3
 - 2. To be mutually encouraged 1 Thess 5:11
 - a. By one another's faith 3 Jn 1:3-4
- B. He wants to have a harvest among them Jn 15:8, 16
- C. He wants to fulfill his obligation: 1 Cor 9:19
 - 1. To preach the gospel
 - a. To the Greeks and non-Greeks
 - b. To the wise and foolish

III Paul Proclaims The Power Of The Gospel

- A. The gospel is nothing to be ashamed of Mk 8:38
- B. The gospel is the power of God 1 Cor 1:18
- C. The gospel is the means of salvation
- D. The gospel is universally available Jn 1:12; 3:36
- E. The gospel reveals a righteousness from God Rom 3:21-24
- F. The gospel requires a life of faith Gal 3:1-3;Col 2:6

PERSONAL APPLICATION

Take some time this week to consider the following:

- 1. The believers in Rome were world-renowned for their *faith*. What characteristic are you generally known for? How would you like to be characterized?
- 2. When you fellowship with other believers, do you generally come to be ministered to, or to minister to others? Read 1 Thess 5:11. What could you do this coming Sunday to be of encouragement to others?
- 3. Read John 15:8, 16. What does this passage teach about God's objective for the believer? What kind of fruit is Jesus talking about? Based on your discoveries, would you describe yourself as fruitful? Why or why not?
- 4. There are two primary reasons that people are afraid to share the gospel: 1) Fear of rejection and 2) Ignorance of the Word. Which do you struggle with most? What steps can you take to overcome this obstacle?
- 5. Paul states that the Christian life is "from faith to faith". What does that actually mean? Why do you think so many of us tend to go from "faith to works"? What are the consequences of going from "faith to works"?
- 6. Take a moment right now to thank God for His free gift of a righteous standing through Jesus Christ. Thank Him that your salvation began by faith (simple belief) and ask Him for grace to finish it by faith.
