- 4. What was the significance of circumcision in Abraham's life? Based on your answer, how would you describe the significance of water baptism and communion? Are they necessary for salvation? If not, what are they for?
- 5. Take a moment to thank God for His indescribable gift of a right standing based on a response of simple faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ. Ask Him for opportunities this week to share this liberating message of God's love and acceptance!
