# Life in the Spirit - Part I

Romans 8:1-17

#### Introduction

### I The Impact Of Life In Christ Jesus

- A. There is now no condemnation Jn 3:18; 5:24
  - 1. For those who are in Christ Jesus Eph 1:13-14
- B. Through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set us free
  - 1. From the law of sin 2 Cor 3:17; Rom 6:18, 22
  - 2. From the law of death 1 Cor 15:55-57

#### **II The Means Of Our Freedom**

- A. The law was powerless to free us because: Heb 7:18-19
  - 1. It was weakened by the sinful flesh James 2:10
- B. God accomplished what the law couldn't do
  - 1. He sent His own Son
    - a. In the likeness of sinful man Heb 2:14-15
    - b. To be a sin offering 2 Cor 5:21
  - 2. He condemned sin in sinful man Rom 6:6
  - 3. He fully met the law's requirements in us
    - a. Who live not according to the sinful nature 1 Jn 4:4
    - b. Who live according to the Spirit Gal 5:22-23

### III The Contrast Between The Flesh And The Spirit

- A. Those who live according to the sinful nature:
  - 1. Have their minds set on what the flesh desires Phil 3:19
  - 2. Live lives marked by death Gal 6:8
  - 3. Are hostile to God Rom 5:10
  - 4. Cannot submit to God's law 1 Cor 2:14
  - 5. Cannot please God 2 Cor 5:9; Eph 5:10
- B. Those who live according to the Spirit
  - 1. Have their minds set on what the Spirit desires Col 3:1-3
  - 2. Are controlled by the Spirit leading to peace Rom 5:1

## **IV** The Glorious Freedom Of The Believer

A. The spiritual condition of the believer

- 1. Not controlled by the sinful nature Gal 5:24
- 2. But controlled by the Spirit Gal 5:16; 1 Cor 6:19-20
- B. The spiritual effect on a believer
  - 1. Your body is dead because of sin Rom 7:25
  - 2. Your spirit is alive because of righteousness
  - 3. God will give life to your mortal bodies thru His Spirit

### V Our Obligation And Privilege

- A. We are not obligated to live according to the sinful nature
  - 1. If we live according to that nature we will die Rom 6:23
- B. We are obligated to live according to the Spirit
  - 1. We can put to death the misdeeds of the body Rom 6:11 a. Resulting in life
    - b. Proving that we are sons of God
  - 2. We do not have a spirit not of fear, but sonship Eph 1:5
    - a. We can call God, "Abba, Father" Mk 14:36
  - 3. We have the Spirit's testimony that:
    - a. We are heirs of God 1 Pet 1:3-5
    - b. We are co-heirs with Christ Eph 1:3
    - c. We will share in His glory 2 Cor 3:18; 1 Pet 1:6-7

#### PERSONAL APPLICATION

- 1. What impact does Paul's declaration that "There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ" have on you? Do you live like you believe this? Why or why not?
- 2. Read Romans 8:5-11. What characteristics mark the mindset of each lifestyle? Which best describes your mindset?
- 3. Paul concluded that he was powerless to fulfill the requirements of the law in his own strength. What remedy does he offer in helping us deal with our sinful nature? [Rom 8:13-14; 6:13,19]
- 4. Write down what you think it means to be *led* by the Spirit in verse 14? Is your life marked by these characteristics?
- 5. Describe the intimacy level in your current relationship with God. Can you speak to Him as *Abba*, *Father*? If not, what may be preventing it? Ask Him to draw you close once again.
