### III The Contrast Between the Law and Faith

- A. The righteousness that comes by the Law
  - 1. Christ is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the law - Matt 5:17; Rom 7:1-4

  - 2. Moses description of righteousness that is by the law

- B. The righteousness that comes by faith
  - 1. It does not require heroic acts - Deut 30:11-14

3. According to Paul, in what manner did the Jews seek to be made right before God? What was the problem with this approach? [Hint: Read Romans 3:20; 7:7-11; Galatians 3:24] Is it possible for Christians to make the same mistake? How so?
4. While the central affirmation of the early church was "Jesus is Lord", everyone else was saying, "Caesar is Lord". What does it mean to confess, "Jesus is Lord"? How is confession related to "belief"? Who (or what) are some "gods or lords" that compete with your unswerving allegiance to Christ?
5. What are the promises that God makes in Romans 10:9-11 to those who believe in and confess Jesus Christ as Lord? Take a moment to thank Him for His great gift and His sure promises!
