Elijah's name means My God is Yahweh

Elíjah: A Prophet and Theologían

A **prophet** is a man or woman chosen by God to deliver messages from Him through writing or speaking or both. **Theology** is anything you know or believe about God.

Where Do We Learn Our Theology?

- Prepare by instruction—study the truths about God
- Learn by experience—trust in what you believe about God

Application

Lesson #1: Prepare by instruction those within our sphere of influence, including ourselves.

Lesson #2: Be ready to Learn by Experience

- Be willing to be moved out of our familiar surroundings.
- Be as willing to be set aside as to be used.
