What was life like for women in the first century AD?

- Greek and Roman women

The Lord Jesus Christ had a radically different value system from that of His culture and of ours today. As the rabbi, Jesus:

- Traveled with and was supported by women (Luke 8)
- Spoke to them in public also in (Luke 8)
- Witnessed to them, the Samaritan woman (John 4)
- Gave priority to their education (Luke 10)
- Allowed them to honor Him (Luke 7)
- Befriended them, Mary and Martha (Luke 10, John11)
