

This week we studied the first commandment:

"You shall have no other gods before me." (Exodus 20:3 NIET)

We studied Exodus 3 and 4: The Burning Bush

God told Moses He was sending him to Pharaoh to bring His people out of the life of slavery they were experiencing in Egypt. Moses responded to God with a series of questions. The second question Moses asked of God is this:

"Moses said to God, 'If I go to the Israelites and tell them, the God of your fathers has sent me to you,; and they ask me, 'What is his name?' - what should I say to them?" (Exodus 20:13 NET)

God responded by telling Moses: "I AM WHO I AM."

### Names are significant in Scripture. They tell us something about the person whose name it is.

This name of God, "I AM WHO I AM," tells us at least 5 things about God (answers on bottom of page):

- 1. God is a \_\_\_\_\_\_. Because He is a person, we can have fellowship with Him.
- 2. God is \_\_\_\_\_\_. He has no beginning and no end and answers to no one.
- 3. God is \_\_\_\_\_\_. He does not need us; we need Him.

Most importantly, this name of God tells us that God is the one True God and worthy of our worship!

These are but 3 of the many attributes of God. An attribute is a characteristic of God that makes Him who He is.
