

This week we looked at the commandment #3:

"You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain..."
(Exodus 20:7a NET)

We studied Exodus 33: Show me Your Glory

This did not please Moses. He made three requests of God:

After the golden calf incident, God told Moses He would not go with them as they journeyed to the Promised Land. God would send an angel in His place.

"Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey. But I will not go up among you, for you are a stiff-necked people, and I might destroy you on the way." (Exodus 33:3 NET)

1. He wanted to _____ God. He did not just want to know about God, he wanted to know God in such a way that his life was changed by it.

2. He wanted God to ______ them. In fact, Moses told God "if Your Presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here." (Exodus 33:15 NET) Moses did not want to travel without God!

3. He asked God to show him His ______. God showed Moses as much as He could without harming him. When He showed Moses His glory, He stood there and proclaimed His name (Ex 34:6 NET): "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, and abounding in loyal love and faithfulness."

God's name sums up the character of God and to misuse it dishonors Him.
