

Evidence for God

- The universe seems well-designed, possessing purpose and intelligence. This design suggests a Master Designer.
- Humanity's possession of moral conscience, intellect, will, and emotion seem to point to a more intelligent Maker who instilled these characteristics into His creation.
- The very existence of a universe rather than nothing at all points in the direction of some original Cause. Scientific theories seem insufficient to explain the ultimate source of the universe.
- Throughout history many people have claimed to speak with and on behalf of God. Although some may be delusional or dishonest, many appear to be sincere and truthful.
- Many men and women from all walks of life have testified to the positive impact of God's existence on their lives personally.

The nature of god

- The Bible indicates that God is loving (Jn 3:16; 1 John 4:7-8), righteous (Ps 11:7), full of justice (Is 61:8), powerful (Ps 24:8), and all-knowing (Ps 139:1-6).
- The Bible is a story of God's active involvement in creating (Gen 1-3) and ruling (Ps 95:3) over all of humanity.

- Assuming God exists, do you think His existence will impact your life in a practical way?
- Do you think it is possible for a person to know God or to communicate with Him?
