

Facts from the bible

- The term "sin" refers to any departure from God's perfect standards of goodness.
- Sin includes not only what we do, but also what we say and think (Matthew 5:21-22; 27-28).
- Sin entered the world when Satan, disguised as a snake, deceived the first human beings, Adam and Eve, and convinced them to disobey God (Genesis 3:1-19).
- As a result of Adam and Eve's sin, everybody is now "infected" with sin (Romans 5:12).
- Nobody is good enough to have a relationship with God — everybody is a sinner (Romans 3:10-12, 23).
- The consequence of sin is spiritual death — eternal separation from God in hell (Romans 1:18; 2:5; 5:12; 2 Thessalonians 1:6-10).
